ANNUAL REPORT



Vintage reopened the center for in-person activity on June 21, 2021 and was the first senior center in Allegheny County to reopen, offering service 5 days per week. Since reopening, we have rebuilt our robust activity calendar, while ensuring that participants have the most up to date information about COVID-19 and how to keep themselves healthy. With an average of 102 participants per day, we were proud to remain a stable, trusted support system for area older adults despite the changes that have occurred due to the pandemic.

We have seen steady growth in attendance and have been able to return to pre-pandemic levels of activity in the building. Programming includes daily connection to community resources to meet basic needs, one-on-one technology coaching, 14 group fitness classes each week (line dance, yoga, chair exercise, tai chi, and more), weekly fine arts classes for quilting, writing, painting and needlework, daily bingo/cards/billiards, various discussion groups, including LGBTQ seniors and Bible study, group computer classes, fitness studio and the reintroduction of restaurant, shopping and cultural trips.

In a survey administered in spring 2022, participants rated the Vintage Center as Very Good – Excellent (Average Score 4.48 on a 5-Point Scale).

In April, Vintage said farewell to Ann Truxell, Vintage's long-time Executive Director, who retired from Vintage after 22 years of service. Vintage is grateful for her strong direction that has positioned Vintage as a respected leader in senior services in Allegheny County and beyond.
